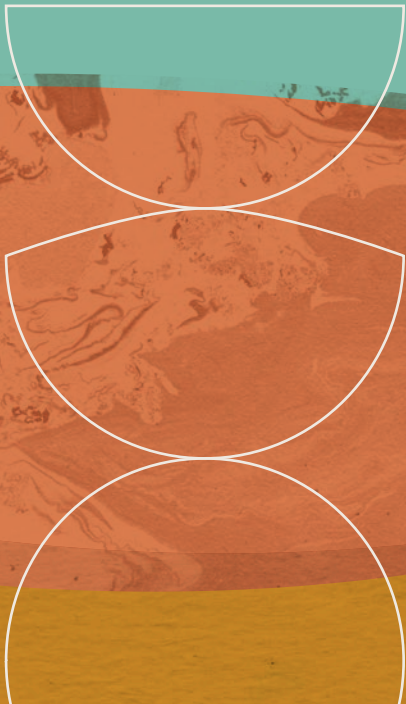

You'll receive an estimate for the agreed-upon project scope (which can be adjusted to include more as we go), an agreement, and you'll pay your deposit.

03

We'll create a Copy Creation calendar to include two rounds of edits and feedback, and we'll finalize when complete.
